***South East Manipur College, Komlathabi: At a Glance***

South East Manipur College, Komlathabi is a premier co-education college located along the state highway No.10, at Komlathabi village in Chandel District. It was established in 1981 during the times when parents, guardian & students were running out of options for further studies in general line. The college has been affiliated to Manipur University till date with permanent affiliation since 1992. The University Grants Commission recognizes the College under section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore has accredited the College with grade B. It has also been updated to a Model Degree College by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under Rashtriya Uchchattar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) in the Year 2018

The College offer courses in Science, Arts, Physical Education and BCA, upto the degree level. Seeing the demand for seats in Vocational Course of Food Processing & Engineering, the management has open the Department of Food Processing Technology from the year 2019 – 2020 Academic Session. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has also granted the opening of Certificate Course in Horticulture under the RUSA Scheme since 2017 – 2018 academic session.

### Teachers' award

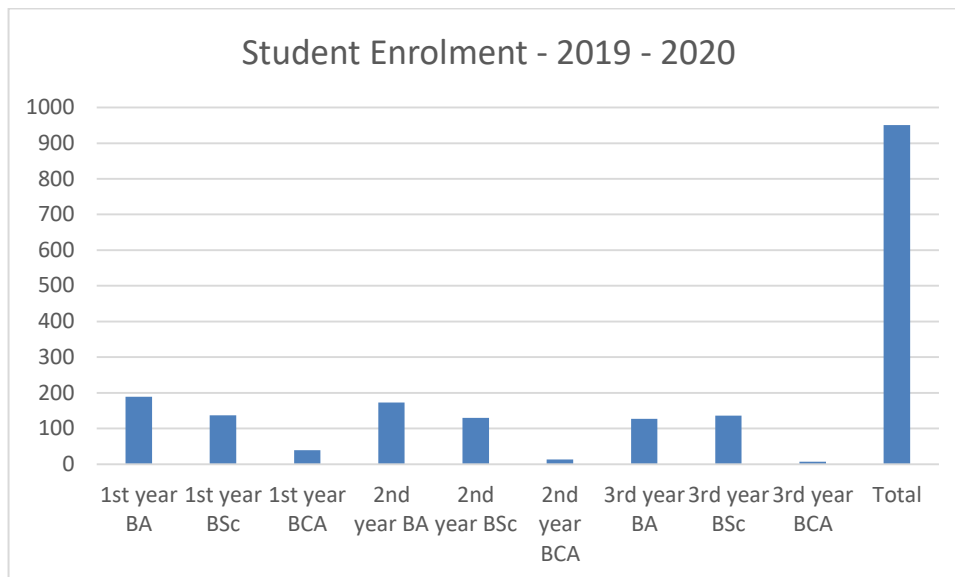

- The total number of students admitted/enrolled in BA/B.Sc/BCA for the academic session 2019 - 2020 is 951. The detail break-up is as follow:

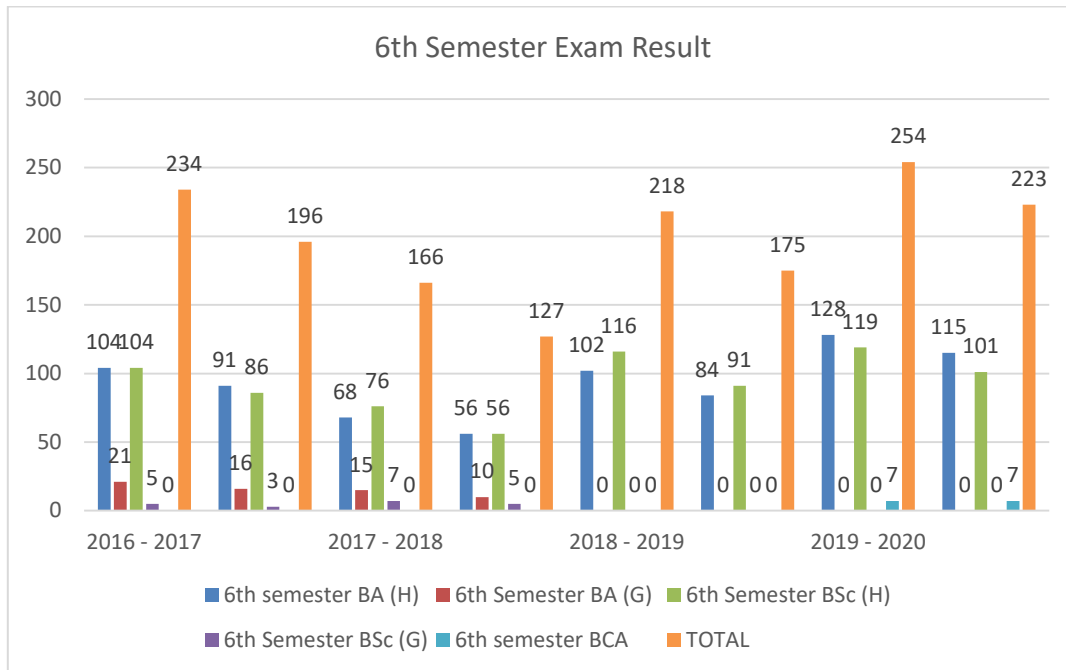
